**Gilchrist Elementary School, Millwork Replacement in nine (9) Classrooms**

The School Board intends to re-advertise the solicitation.

Per Section 119.071(1), (b), 3, F.S., If an agency rejects all bid in response to a competitive solicitation and the agency concurrently provides notice of its intent to reissue the competitive solicitation, the rejected bids remain exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution until such time as the agency provides notice of an intended decision concerning the reissued competitive solicitation or until the agency withdraws the reissued competitive solicitation, or 12 months after the initial agency notice rejecting all bids.

Per Section 120.57(3), F.S., a Notice of Intent to Protest or a Formal Written Protest must be filed with the District's Purchasing Department within the timeframes established in Florida Statutes (F.S.). Filings may be made physically at 3397 W. Tharpe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32303, or via email to [bidprotests@leonschools.net](mailto:bidprotests@leonschools.net). Protests must be made in compliance with Rules 28-110.003 and 28-110.004, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Filings received on a weekend, District holiday, or after 5:00 p.m. will be filed the next business day.

Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), F.S., or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, F.S.
