- Subsequent screenings at recommended ages



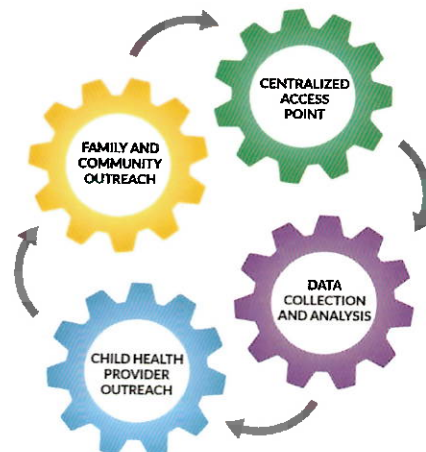
Help Me Grow works through four key components:

Family & Community Outreach

promotes HMGF, facilitates provider networking, and supports families to bolster children's healthy development.

Child Health Provider Outreach

supports early detection and intervention efforts and connects medical providers to community resources that support their patients.



A Centralized Telephone Access Point (2-1-1 helpline) assists families and professionals in connecting children to community resources.

Data Collection & Analysis

identifies gaps in and barriers to a coordinated system of services for children and families and informs continuous quality improvement efforts.

How can you benefit from collaborating with HMGF?

Early Intervention (EI) Providers:

HMGF connects your families to other community resources when their child is not eligible for EI or preschool special education services.

Child Care Providers:

HMGF provides free training and materials for developmental and behavioral screenings at your site and connects your families to community services.

Family Service Organizations:

HMGF provides your families with free developmental screenings and care coordination services, including referrals and follow-up, to ensure that needed services were received.

Home Visiting Providers:

HMGF can partner with home visitors to implement or share developmental or social-emotional screenings and help families access needed services.

Health Care Providers:

HMGF assists your patients with developmental screenings and connects them to needed services and shares patient and referral outcomes with providers.

Human Services/Basic Needs Providers:

HMGF can support access to basic needs and human services (e.g., housing, food, employment), stabilizing the family so they can focus on helping their child.
