- Lack of programs that promote walking and bicycling

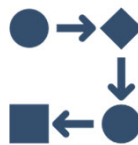

The Process



- Each year (except 2023), local municipalities from across the State of Florida submit applications to FDOT Safe Routes To School (SRTS)
- The submittals are reviewed by the FDOT SRTS Program Staff and Transportation Engineers
- If approved, the projects are funded in the five-year work program by FDOT

In 2023, the National SRTS Program started to redefine the parameters and requirements and did not accept any applications.

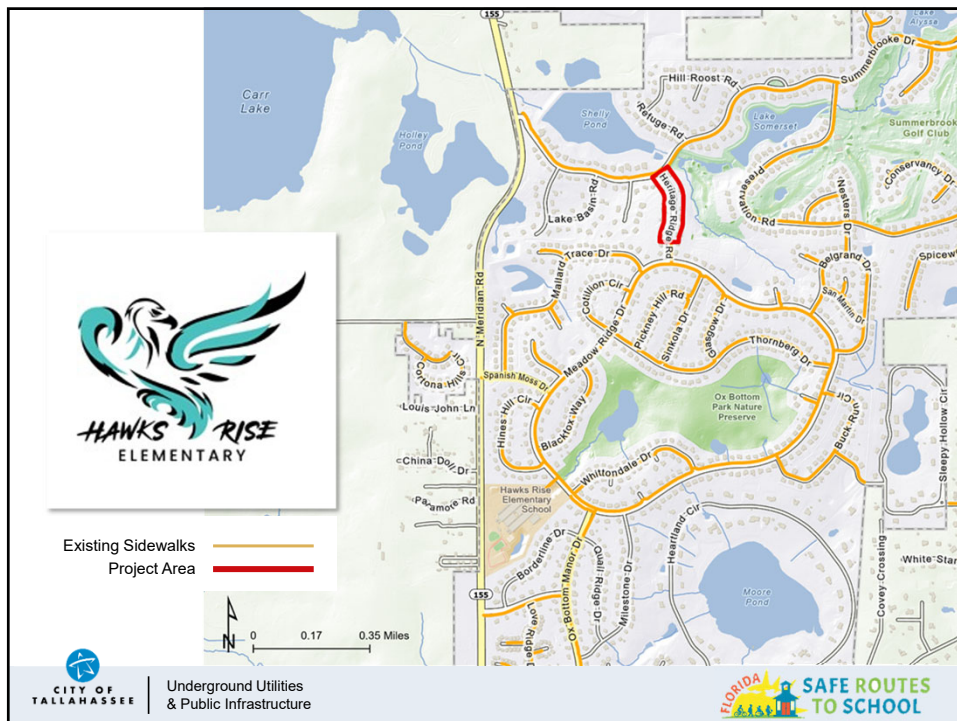

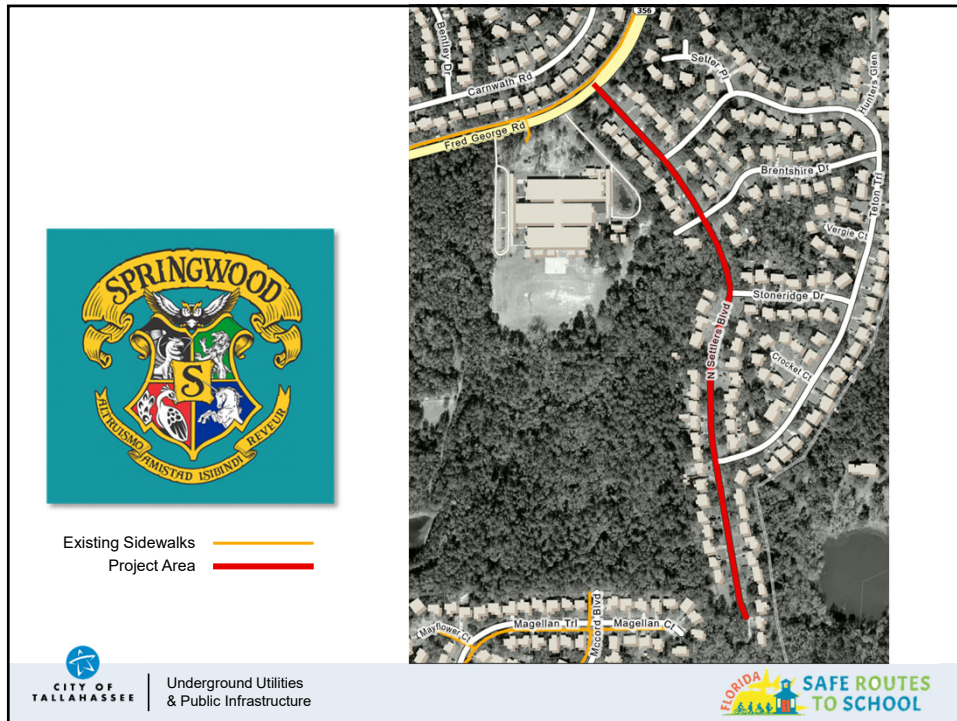
