grading system

Earning Credit

- All courses earn .50 credit upon successful completion of each semester.
- State EOC results account for 30% of your final grade. This currently includes Algebra I, Geometry, and Biology.
- Per grading period - you must earn a passing grade during the final grading period and/or exam to earn credit for the semester.

- **A 90% - 100%**
- **B 80% - 89%**
- **C 70% - 79%**
- **D 60% - 69%**
- **F 50% - 59%**

Grade point average (GPA)

- **GPA**

- Students will have an official transcript with state unweighted, and district weighted GPA after the completion of one semester of high school course work

- **Weighted GPA**

- Honors + gifted courses are awarded an extra .25 (.50 year) for a semester grade of a C or better ex: A = 4.5
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses are awarded an extra .50 (1.0 year) for a semester grade of C or higher ex: A = 5

- **Unweighted GPA - Quality Points**

- Is based on all courses awarded the standard grading of
- (A) 4.0
- (B) 3.0
- (C) 2.0
- (D) 1.0

Speaking impact

- Students who receive a C or lower in high school credit course in middle school can retake course for grade replacement. Must retake course freshmen year.
- Students NEED a 2.0 UNWEIGHTED GPA to graduate from Lincoln High School.

credit recovery

What is credit recovery?

If you fail a class that is necessary for graduation, you will have to make that class up by "credit recovery"

What are some ways to recover classes?

- Virtual School
 - ACE
- PLATO (seniors only)
- No summer school at LHS

What happens with the other classes I am taking?

When you are recovering a class, you will either have to recover that class during summer, on your own time, or during the school year, along with the other classes you are enrolled in.

■ Pre-Planned Absence

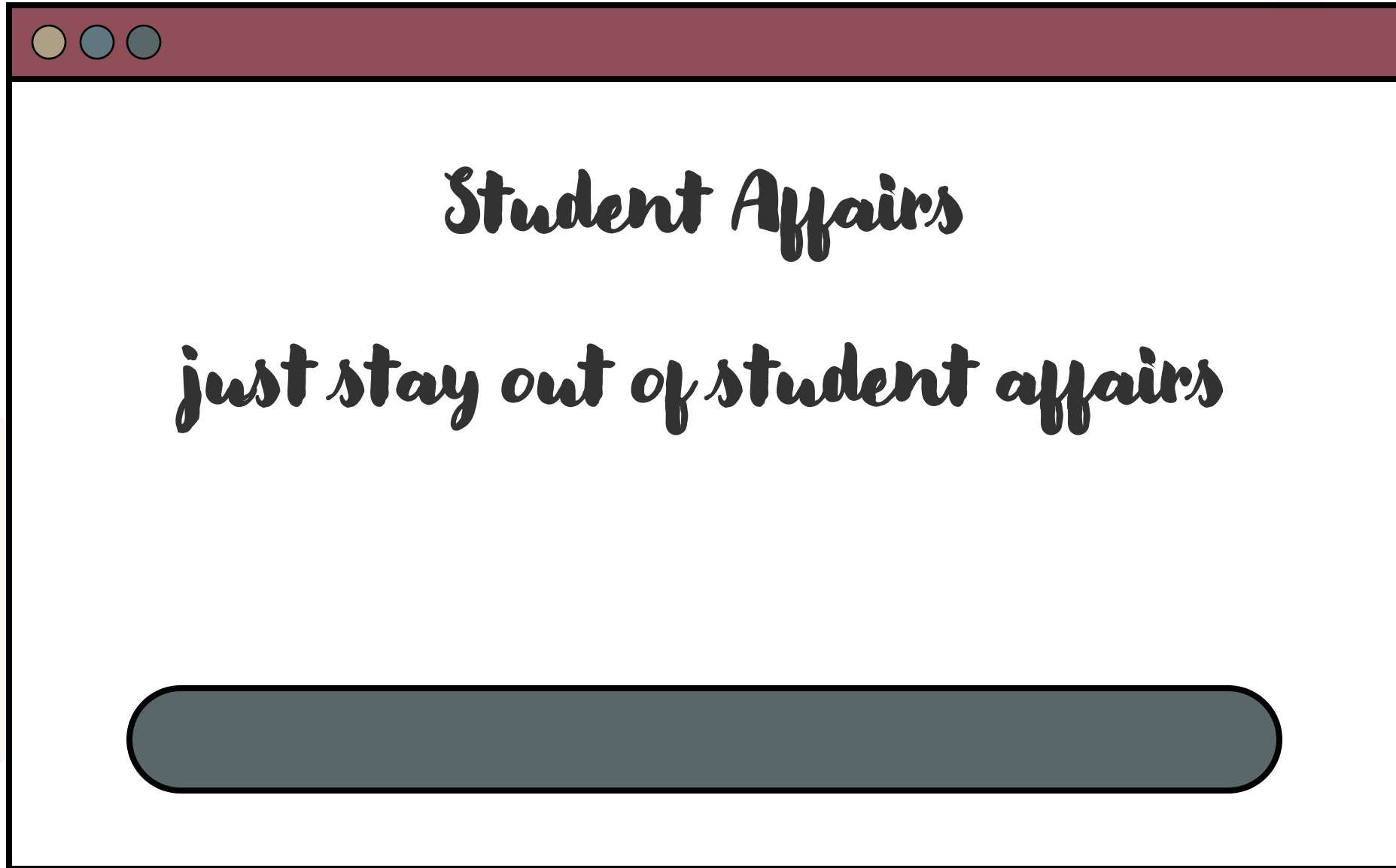
Get with your teachers BEFORE you are absent to let them know you will be missing
