We are proud to incorporate resources from Florida's First Lady, Casey DeSantis, and her Resiliency Toolkit, which assists educators in teaching character education. These resources may also be beneficial for you to explore at home.

This year, students will receive instruction for grades 6-8 through the following initiatives:

- Resiliency Day: On December 6th, 2024, all students will participate in interactive lessons lasting 30-50 minutes via Canvas. Students will follow a modified bell schedule and remain in a familiar class setting.
- **Content Sources:** Leon County Schools will utilize materials from The Jason Foundation, Safer, Smarter Teens, and the Resiliency Toolkit.
