## **North Florida Gold Cup Award Academic Scholarship For High School Seniors Enrolled in Leon and Gadsden Counties, Florida**

### **GUIDELINES**

**Purpose:** To provide two (2) scholarships to deserving graduating seniors attending a public high school in Leon or Gadsden counties in Florida. The students must be interested in enrolling in an institution of higher education, pursuing a four-year degree with an interest in Music Education, Elementary Education, Secondary Education, Health Care, Social Sciences or a Business related major.

**Award Components:** One (1) \$1,000 scholarship and a certificate of achievement will be awarded to the student that is selected by the North Florida Gold Cup Award Scholarship Committee.

#### **Criteria:**

1. Applicant must be a Leon County, Florida resident, having earned a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) that equates to a “B” average or higher.
2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant must be registered as a full-time college/university student at the beginning of the fall term following high school graduation.
4. Applicant must demonstrate overall academic excellence.

#### **Application Process: (Applicant Must Submit)**

1. Completed typed or handwritten application form. **Handwritten applications must be neatly written and legible (in ink). Incomplete applications will not be processed.**
2. A brief **typed written cover letter** addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The information outlined below should be submitted in **NARRATIVE** form, **not to exceed two (2) typed pages.**

The applicant will:

- a. tell us about yourself (biographical background information).
- b. share with the Committee your high school academic success to include your clubs/organizational affiliations, volunteer/work related experiences, and honors/awards (to include community awards/recognitions).
- c. provide the Committee with your high school transcript to reflect the Grade Point Average.



- d. share with the Committee your goals and aspirations, and how a degree of higher education will prepare you for career success.
- e. provide a cap and gown photo with your application.

The **deadline** for submitting the application is **Tuesday, April 15, 2025**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.

**Special Note:** Should the chosen recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) fail to attend an accredited college or university the upcoming fall term, the applicant who was judged as an alternate will receive the award providing he or she has enrolled in an accredited college or university with an intent to pursue one of the academic courses of study specified under the "Purpose" outlined in this document. Confirmation of college or university enrollment will be requested prior to funding the awards.

Your official/final class schedule must be provided by the Registrars office for the institution that you are attending. Scholarship checks will be awarded (1) week after your document is provided to the North Florida Gold Cup Awards Scholarship Committee, the Fall Semester of your enrollment.
