This week's question was: Do all balls bounce? We tested lots of balls and found that most balls do bounce. In small groups, we guessed how many kindness balls were in the Kindness Jar. Then sorted and counted the balls. Everyone predicted how many times their ball would bounce, then tested their predictions. We also experimented dropping them high and low to see which caused more bounces. We bounced and counted different balls and talked about more and fewer. We practiced rhyming words by reading several nursery rhymes and the Dr. Suess book, One Fish, Two Fish, Red Fish, Blue Fish. We also played a rhyming game with puzzle pieces and a rhyming game on the smart board. Today, we measured how big around our balls were using string. Then we compared the lengths of the strings. Finally, we bounced the balls to see which balls bounced the most and the highest.

Our emotion of the week was anger. We talked about what makes us feel angry and things we can do when we feel angry. We learned a new calming breath this week called, The Balloon. Ask your child to demonstrate it for you.

Our featured books this week were: The Billy Goats Gruff, Have a Ball, The Little Red Hen and Bounce.
