This week's questions were: What are the rules at school? And What happens at school? We had a several great discussions about both questions. Our rules are: use nice hands, feet and words, listen to your teachers and use walking feet (except on the playground).

We started our Handwriting Without Tears (HWT) workbook today. This program will help our students develop and/or improve proper grasp and pressure with writing instruments, and letter and number formation.

In our reading and math small groups, we worked on positional words (in, out, over, under, above, near, etc.) while playing the games: Can You Find It? Where Does It Belong and Where's the Beanbag? We like to have fun while we learn. We also made our names from wooden big lines, little lines, big curves and small curves. We love singing and dancing with the wooden pieces, too. We use them regularly for the hokey pokey and a song called, Tap Big Lines. These wooden pieces are part of our HWT curriculum.

We read several great books including, Charlie Anderson, Jalapeno Bagels and Penny Butter Fudge. After we read Jalapeño Bagels, we ate bagels with jalapeño cream cheese. After we read Penny Butter Fudge, we made fudge from sun butter. The children helped us measure the ingredients and sift the powdered sugar. They all loved it. They each have a bag in their backpacks. We saved some fudge for our friends that were absent.

We have a pre-k activity fee that is due by 9/13/24. The fee is \$25 and includes a subscription to My Big World, 6 Book Club books for your home library and craft and cooking supplies. Please let me know if you need help with this fee or have questions.
