Up**

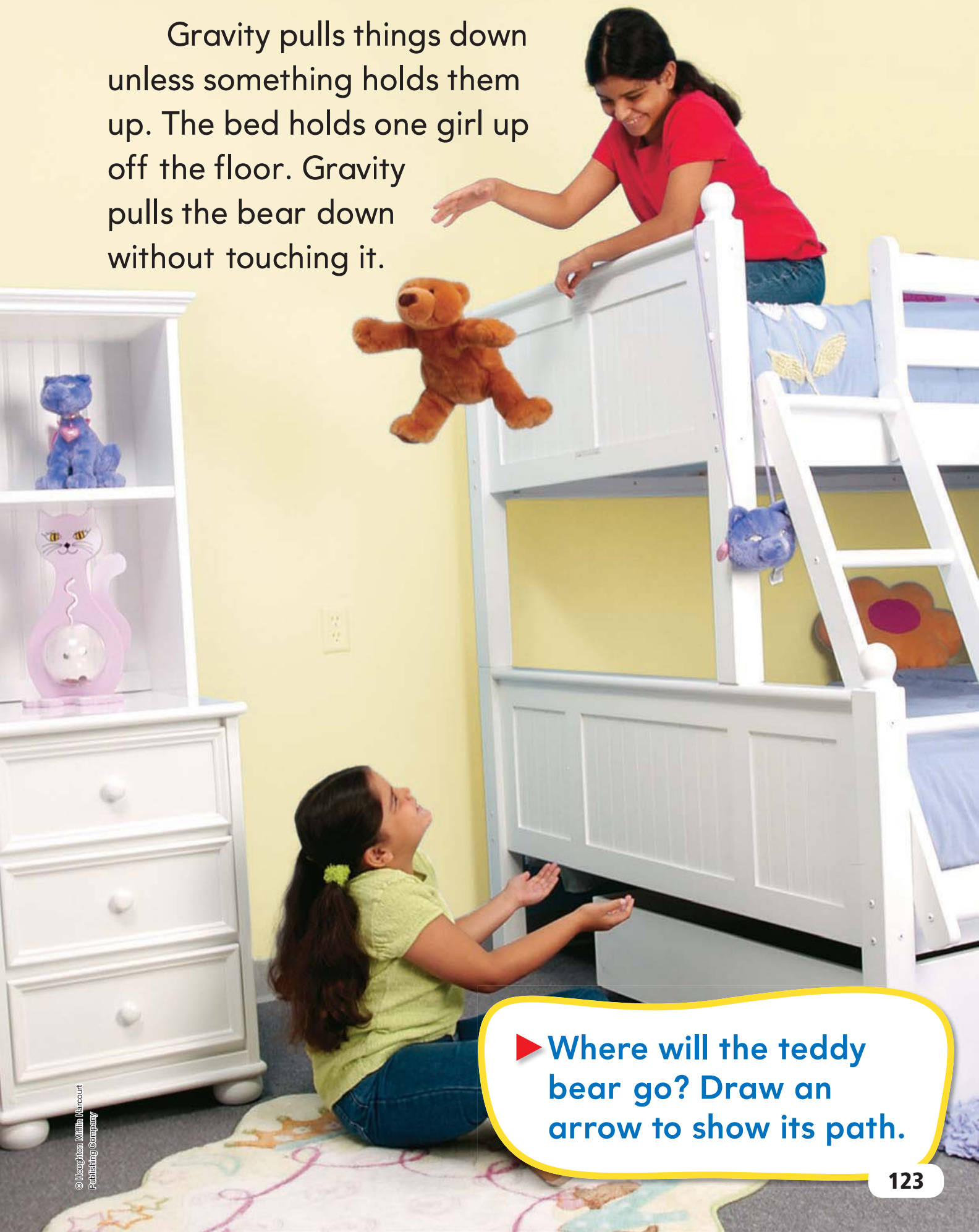
**Must Come

Soon gravity will pull the ball back down.

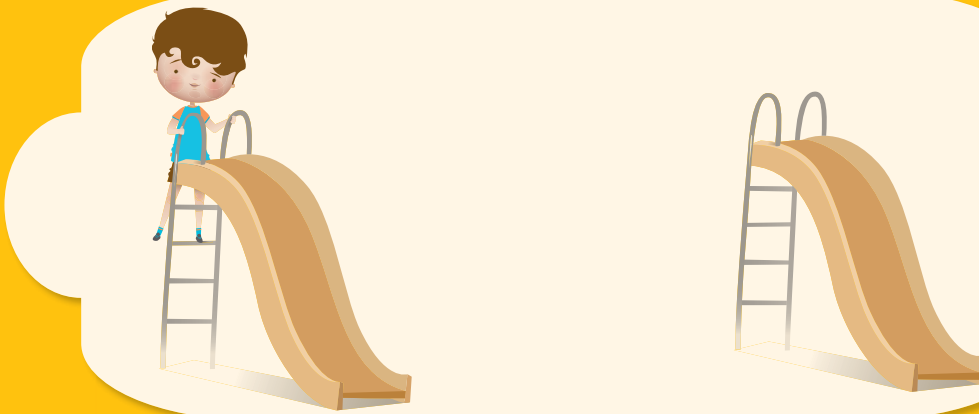


The girl pushes against gravity as she throws the ball.
