#### Process:

- 1. Start heating wax
- 2. Locate/prepare Urea water
- 3. Draw out pattern or choose to go with the flow!
- 4. Cut and stretch fabric on a frame
- 5. Use Tjanting or a wax paintbrush to draw on design
- 6. Let dry
- 7. Mix up dye colors
- 8. Paint on or dip dye your fabric

### Tips:

- No horseplay!
- Share dye with fellow students. Don't make duplicate colors.
- Use the tjanting for small lines and brushes for broad strokes or to fill in large areas.
- If you blow on the tjanting before you start the wax will flow a bit slower at the beginning
- Make sure you connect lines so that colors do not bleed together

## Assignment

Your assignment is to create a batik piece of an animal, insect of even a creature. We can project pictures onto the board for you to trace.
