Email us a flyer of the event and we will post it around the Media Center.

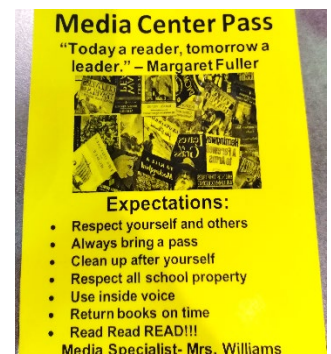
***Need an interesting book to read?**
