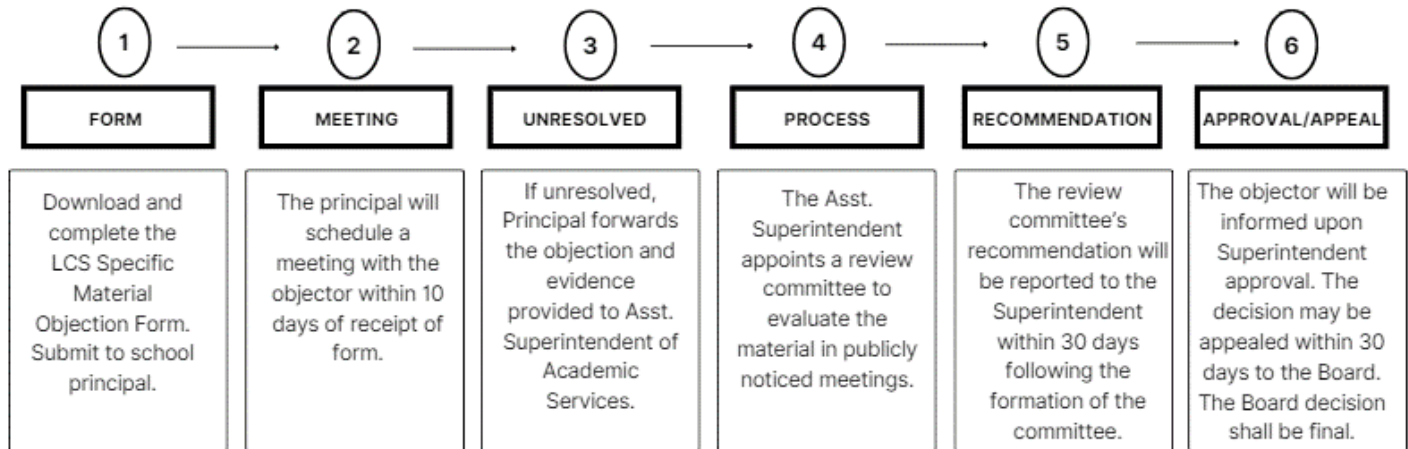




LCS Specific Material Objection Form

Part I: Leon County Schools [Policy 2522.01](#): Challenges to Adoption or Use of Instructional, Library, or Reading List Materials.

Parents and residents of Leon County may object to the use of a specific instructional material in the classroom, made available in a school library, or included on a reading list, based on the criteria set forth in [F.S. 1006.28\(2\)\(a\)2](#). or [F.S. 1014.05\(1\)\(c\)](#). The objection process is as follows:



Per F.S.1006.28(2)(a)6, if a parent disagrees with the determination made by the Board, they may request the Commissioner of Education to appoint a special magistrate to review the decision and make a recommendation to the State Board of Education.

Parents and residents shall object to the use of a specific material by completing the Specific Material Objection Form for the following types of materials: 1). Materials used in a classroom in the district; 2). Materials made available to students in a school or classroom library; and 3). Materials included on a school or classroom reading list.

Any material that is subject to an objection on the basis that it is pornographic or prohibited under F.S. 847.012 or depicts or describes sexual conduct as defined in F.S. 847.001(19) (unless such material is for a course required by F.S. 1003.46, F.S. 1003.42(2)(n)1.g., F.S. 1003.42(2)(n)3., or identified by State Board of Education rule) must be removed within five (5) school days of receipt of the objection and remain unavailable to students of that school until the objection is resolved.

**All sections of the form must be completed for the process to move forward.
Incomplete forms will be returned to the objector for completion.**

SUNSHINE LAW AND PUBLIC RECORDS CAUTION: Please note that Florida has a very broad Public Records Law. Virtually all written communications to or from the School Board of Leon County, Florida personnel, including this form, are public records available to the public and media upon request. By signing and/or submitting this form to the Leon County School District, you acknowledge and agree that all information which you include on the form is subject to disclosure by the District.
