Example: It's a house.

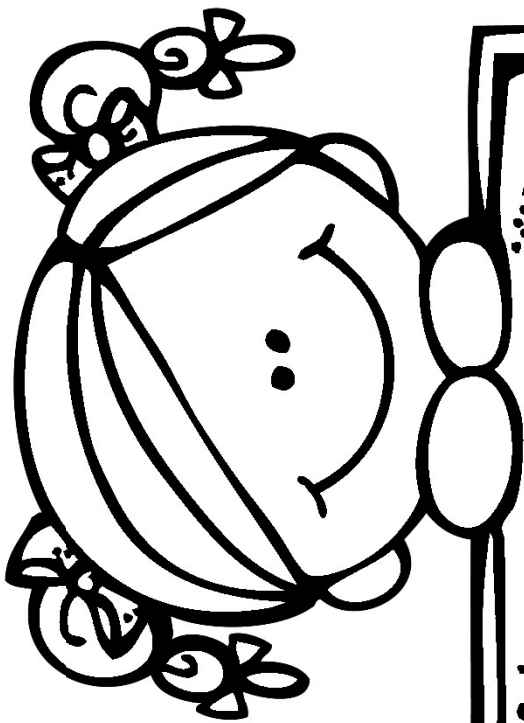
Teacher Note:

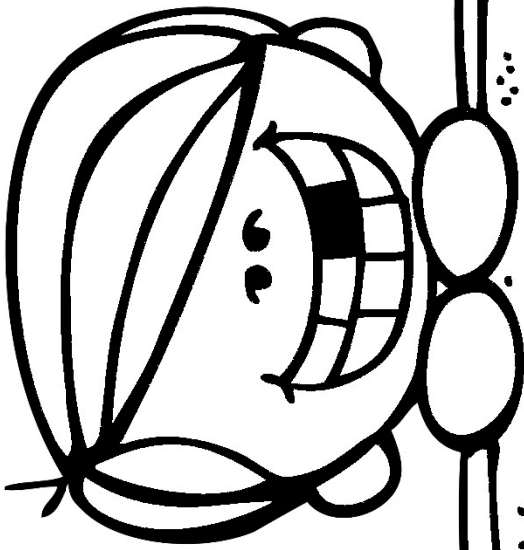

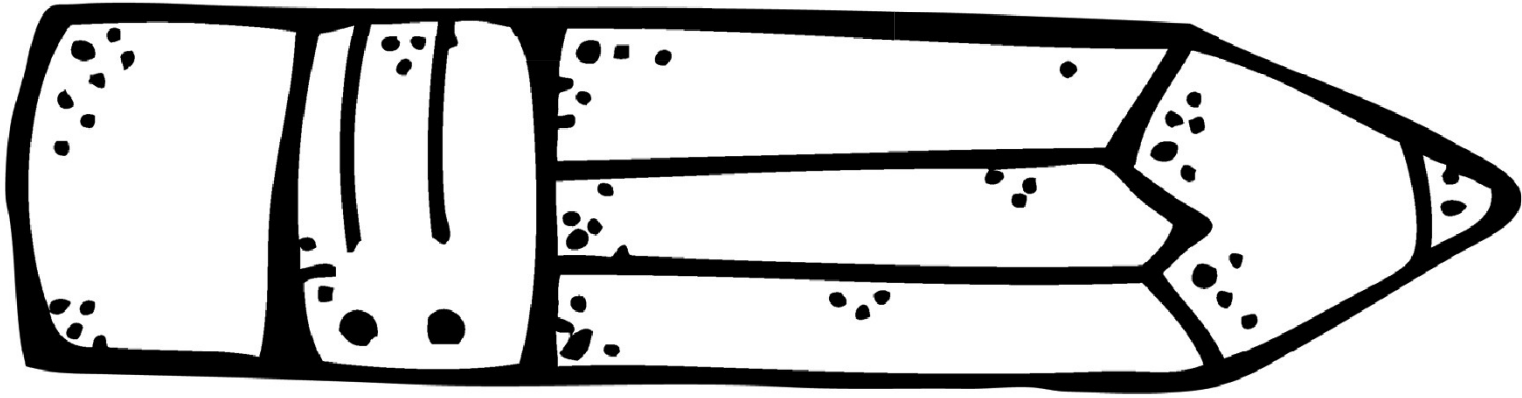

Choose which template your students need. They can trace the entire alphabet, fill in the missing letters, write the whole alphabet, write just the capital letters, or write just the lower case letters.

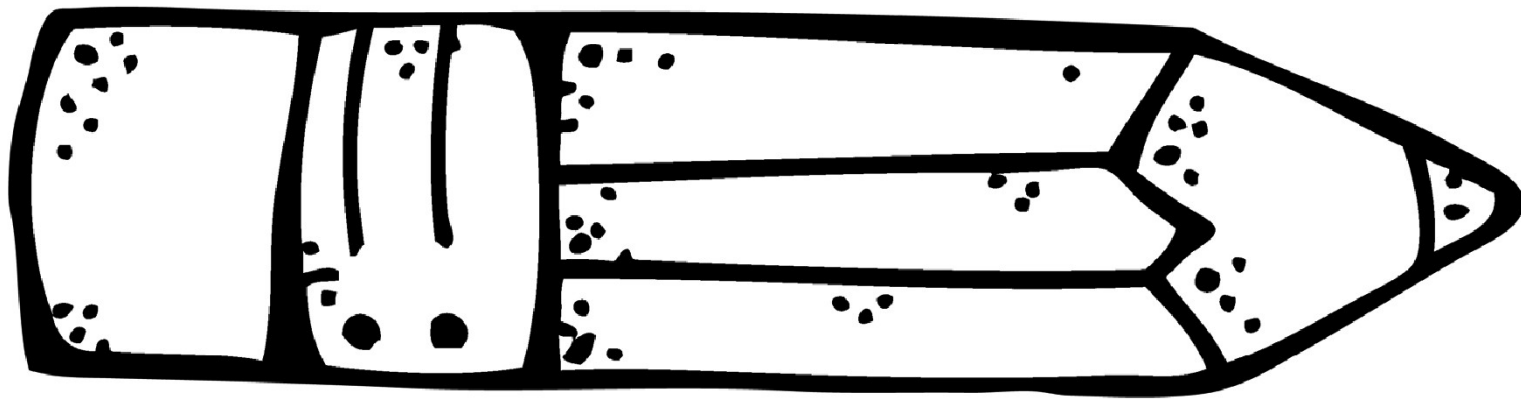
